DESCRIPTION OF CURRENT PROGRAMS, ACTIVITIES AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

The Watershed Center currently operates three major programs: 1) Implementing our state and federally-approved watershed protection plan; 2) our Baykeeper program which focuses on public education and advocacy work; and 3) water quality monitoring which currently consists of E. Coli monitoring at beaches and monitoring stream health utilizing volunteers.

The Center and its partners, through our watershed protection plan, have implemented on-the-ground projects that are now preventing 1,200 tons of sediment, 432 pounds of phosphorus and 976 pounds of nitrogen from entering the Grand Traverse Bay watershed every year.
